First 10%	no charge
Next 10%	per statement
Over 20% (Summer)	per statement
Over 20% (Winter)	per statement

Daily Deficiency Imbalance Charge:

For any day on which the Daily Delivery Quantity is greater than the Daily Transportation Quantity, the customer shall pay a Deficiency Imbalance Charge on the deficiency quantity, as follows:
