- (5) As described in the "Capacity Release Service" section under this Service Classification, a firm Customer in a Group may be required by the Company to participate in the Capacity Release Service. Although the capacity release shall be from the Company to the Customer, the Customer may re-release the capacity, subject to the Company's recall rights. If the Customer leaves a Group, the Customer retains the capacity release rights, unless the Customer terminates its Service Classification No. 9 service with the Company, in which case the Company shall have the option to terminate the capacity release.
- (6) The Company may, at its discretion, reject an application from a Small Customer Aggregation Group when the aggregate therm sales of Converting Customers, excluding the accounts of the City of New York that may elect to be aggregated for the purpose of qualifying for Transportation Service, reach the following:
  - (a) for the 12 months ending April 30, 1997: when the annual therm sales of Converting Customers equals or exceeds 5 percent of the total Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 therm sales for the 12 months ending December 31, 1995, normalized for weather;
  - (b) for the 12 months ending April 30, 1998: when the annual therm sales of Converting Customers equals or exceeds 10 percent of the total Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 therm sales for the 12 months ending December 31, 1995, normalized for weather; and
  - (c) for the 12 months ending April 30, 1999: when the annual therm sales of Converting Customers equals or exceeds 15 percent of the total Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 therm sales for the 12 months ending December 31, 1995, normalized for weather.
