Availability of Firm Sales Service:

A Customer may return to firm sales service under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 following the initial term of service under this Service Classification by providing the Company with written notice of termination two (2) months before the expiration of the term.

A Customer may also return to firm sales service under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 during the initial year of service under this Service Classification, if the customer's Seller has terminated supplying natural gas to the Customer before completion of the term and the Customer is unable to contract for gas supply with another qualified Seller for the remainder of such term, by providing the Company with written notice of termination. In such event, the Company will return the Customer to firm sales service on the first day of the month immediately following thirty (30) days after receiving such notice. The Company will continue to provide Back-up and Balancing Services until service under this Service Classification has terminated and such reclassification becomes effective.

If during the initial year or in any subsequent year, "Brooklyn Union" becomes aware of a disqualification of a customer's Seller, the Company will attempt to notify such Customer. If this notice cannot be accomplished or if this Customer does not notify "Brooklyn Union" of its election of another qualified Seller within 30 days of this initial attempt at notification, the Company will assume at that time that the Customer has provided written notice of termination. During the period between when a customer's Seller has terminated supplying natural gas and prior to the Customer receiving gas either from a new marketer or under "Brooklyn Union" Sales Services, the Company will provide gas to the Customer and increase the balance in the Commodity Account by the amount provided to the Customer.

At any time outside this initial term, a Customer may return to firm sales service under Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, and 3 following any term other than its initial term of service under this Service Classification if:

- (i) the Company has received timely written notice of termination under this Service Classification; and
- (ii) the Company deems such service to be generally available to new service applicants.

Special Provisions:

- (a) Remote Reading Devices: Customers choosing a remote reading device are required to provide a telephone connection point within fifteen (15) feet of the remote reading device and bear all applicable telephone charges for communicating meter usage information to the Company. All Customers electing not to have a remote reading device installed are required to sign a statement indicating that they choose not to be metered by such device and are willing to accept the accuracy of the company's estimates for the purpose of calculating the customer's DTQ.
- (b) Service Separately Metered: Service provided under this Service Classification shall be separately metered and shall not be combined with service provided by the Company under any other Service Classification.
