SERVICE CLASSIFICATION No. 14

NATURAL GAS VEHICLE (NGV) SERVICE

Customer Eligibility:

Service Classification No. 14 shall be available to any customer for use in fueling natural gas vehicles upon written application and acceptance by the Company.

All customers served under this service classification are subject to interruption as provided in the Special Provisions herein.

Availability of Service:

Service is available on a first-come, first-serve basis at compressor stations designated by the Company.

Character of Service:

The Company will provide gas to the customer that contains not less than 975 BTU per cubic foot measured on a dry basis at standard temperature and pressure. The maximum delivery pressure will be 3,000 pounds per square inch gauge at an ambient temperature of 70° Fahrenheit. The mass of gas registered at the compressed natural gas meter will be in pounds and will be converted to Ccf by multiplying the pounds by a factor of 0.2250 Ccf per pound. Service is interruptible at the option of the Company after not less than two hours notice.

Heating Value Adjustment:

Volumes of gas in Ccf, as calculated from measured mass, will be converted to therms as explained on General Information Leaf No. 38.
