CUSTOMERS OPERATING COGENERATION FACILITIES

APPLICABLE TO USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Non-utility cogeneration facility having an annual consumption in excess of 2,000,000,000 cubic feet.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE:

Off-Peak Firm Sales of Company-owned gas primarily natural gas, minimum B.T.U. content 950 Btu per Mcf, normal pressure not less than 4 inches.

The Company and the Customer shall enter into an Agreement which specifies the maximum total days (hours) during each winter period (1 November through 31 March) that the Company may suspend delivery of gas to the Customer.

Each period of suspension of deliveries shall be of no less than four (4) consecutive hours.

As a minimum, suspension will occur on the Peak Day and Three Day Peak periods of maximum sales gas sendout for which the average daily temperature is 15 degrees Fahrenheit or less. The Customer shall not be deemed demand-cost causative in the unlikely event that it is sold gas on a day on which the average temperature is above 15 F, but which unexpectedly is determined to be a peak sendout day or part of a three-day peak sendout.

The Company shall provide the Customer with at least four (4) hours advance notice of each suspension of gas deliveries, along with an estimate of the expected duration of the suspension. Subject to the minimum suspension period of four (4) hours, the Company shall notify the Customer and recommence delivery of gas as soon as the Company reasonably determines that the conditions prompting the suspension will not occur or have passed.
