The FERC Order 636 Transition Costs will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- c. All volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed the Credit/Surcharge for Interruptible and Firm Dual Fuel Sales and Transportation Service Benefits as determined in General Information Section 12. The Credit/Surcharge for Interruptible and Firm Dual Fuel Sales and Transportation Service Benefits will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
