I. Energy Use by Convenience Outlets

When customer has convenience outlets on customers owned or leased facilities, the energy used by the convenience outlets is to be billed separately under S.C. No. 2 of the General Electric Tariff.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly energy charge per street lighting district is \$4.66.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due and payable on or before the twenty-fifth (25th) day of the calendar month following the month for which the bill is rendered and shall thereafter be subject to a late payment charge of one and one-half percent (1 1/2%) pursuant to Rule 26.4 of the General Electric Tariff.

TERM:

One year from year to year thereafter until canceled at the end of any one year term by either party upon ninety (90) days prior written notice to the other.

SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

A. Written application for service upon Company's Form "P" is required, to which a schedule designated Schedule "W" shall be attached. The Schedule "W" will list the lamp sizes and quantities for which energy will be supplied initially. Such application and attached schedule, when accepted by Company, shall constitute an agreement between customer and Company, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this service classification.
