STREET LIGHTING

**MINIMUM CHARGE:**

No minimum monthly charge.

**TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid without imposition of a charge for late payment if paid in full on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill which shall be at least 20 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1½%) per month on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late payment charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.

**TERM:**

- A) For installation in public street or highway, five (5) years commencing at the date of installation and thereafter from year to year until canceled upon 30 days written or verbal notice.
- B) When service has been discontinued at the request of the customer, and the customer applies for reconnection of service within six (6) months, there shall be a reconnection charge of \$10.00 per luminaire. Reconnection shall be made only during regular working hours of the electric department, Monday through Friday.

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS:**

- A) Upon application, the Village will furnish, own, operate, and maintain lighting equipment as follows at the monthly rates shown herein.
