 - when an emergency may threaten the health or safety of a person, the surrounding area or the Company's distribution system.
 - 2. The Company will conduct a field inspection:
 - a. as soon as reasonably possible, but no more than <u>sixty (60)</u> <u>calendar days</u> after a customer request or
 - b. upon receiving a directive by the Public Service Commission or its designee.
