B. When demand is so determined by measurement, the billing demand shall be the highest 15 minute integrated demand established in the billing period, but not less than 75% of the highest demand established during the preceding 12 months or 15 kilowatts.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid without imposition of a charge for late payment if paid in full on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill which shall be at least 20 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A monthly late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1½%) per month on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late payment charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.

TERM

- A. Single Phase Service: One month and thereafter until terminated by three days notice, provided that customer is not subject to certain provisions under Rule (V) of the NYMPA generic tariff.
- B. Three Phase Service: One month and thereafter until terminated by three days' notice, provided that customer is not subject to certain provisions under Rule (V) of the NYMPA generic tariff.
