C. Obligation to Serve - Residential:

- (1) where prevented by labor strikes or precluded by law;
- (2) where precluded by consideration of public safety;
- (3) where the applicant fails to pay, or agree in writing to pay, reasonably chargeable material and installation costs relating to temporary or permanent main extensions or service laterals as required by this tariff or fails to comply with the Residential Insulation Standards contained herein; or
