### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### 1. TERRITORY TO WHICH SCHEDULE APPLIES:

These rules and regulations are applicable to all schedules for gas service issued or adopted by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (the "Company"), except as otherwise provided in individual rate schedules. Detailed listings of the territory to which this schedule applies appear in each rate schedule.

#### 2. RULES RELATING TO THE INSTALLATION OF MAINS, SERVICES, EXTENSIONS, ETC.:

A. Definitions - The following words and terms, when used in these rules, will have the meaning:

- (1) Main - A pipeline located on a public or private right-of-way which is generally available or used to transport gas to more than one (1) service line.
- (2) Service Line - Piping, including associated metering and pressure reducing appurtenances, that transports gas below grade from a main to the first accessible fitting inside the wall of a customer's building when a meter is located within the building; if a meter is located outside the building, the service line will be deemed to terminate at the outside of the building foundation wall.
- (3) Public Right-of-Way - The territorial limits of any street, avenue, road or way (other than a limited access thoroughfare) that is for any highway purpose under the jurisdiction of the State of New York or the legislative body of any county, city, town or village and is open to the public use.
- (4) Adjusted Gas Revenue - The revenue realized from the applicable service classification prices and charges, minus revenue taxes, the minimum charge and the cost of gas.

B. When an application for gas service is made to the Company by the owner or occupant of a building situated on property abutting on or having access to any public right-of-way, in which the governmental authority having jurisdiction will permit the Company to install and maintain facilities, the Company will render the service requested in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.B. of this Schedule.
