information as to the aggregator's legal structure; its officers, partners, or proprietors; trade references; bank references; recent financial statements; and such other credit information as might reasonably be required in the exercise of due diligence by a potential creditor of the aggregator.

c. Public Service Commission Requirements Aggregators must file with the Public Service Commission a copy of its standard contract and warrants that they have complied with the requirements set forth in the Public Service Commission's Order dated March 28, 1996, in Case 95-G-1048.

d. Curtailment Plans Aggregators must provide to Niagara Mohawk a copy of their plan for curtailment of their customers in the event of inadequate gas supplies.

e. Terms of Payment - Bills are due and payable when rendered, which will be the date the bill is personally served or three calendar days after the mailing of the bill. Full payment must be received on or before the date shown on the bill to avoid a late payment charge of one and one-half percent. The one and one-half percent per monthly billing period shall be applied to all amounts previously billed under this tariff including arrears and unpaid late payment charges applied to previous bills. The date specified on the bill shall be at least ten (10) calendar days subsequent to the date the bill is rendered.

Pooled Balancing Service

Pooled Balancing Service permits an aggregator to pool the usage of a group of eligible customers for the purpose of determining imbalances.

a. Customer Eligibility. Pooled Balancing Service is available to customers served under Service Classifications 5 Non-DCA, 7 Non-DCA, S.C. 8, S.C. 5I and S.C. 9 (for contracts executed on and after the effective date of this tariff leaf) who have an Approved Remote Meter as defined in Rule 13 of this tariff. To receive Pooled Balancing Service, a customer must designate an approved aggregator by submitting Aggregator Form 2 to Niagara Mohawk at least 21 days prior to the first day of the month in which the service is to commence. Submission may be by fax. The Aggregator Form 2 must be signed by the customer and the aggregator and must specify the term during which the aggregator is authorized to act on behalf of the customer.
