Applicable to any customer that is not a member of an aggregated group and whose annual usage exceeds 5,000 Dth.

(2) Balancing Service Option or Functional Storage Service Option

Upon applying for firm transportation service under Service Classification No. 6, a customer must elect either the Balancing Service Option or Functional Storage Service Option.

(A) Balancing Service Option

The Balancing Service Option provides for a Seller to deliver gas to the Company on behalf of its customer based on the customer's average daily usage for the same month last year, weather normalized and restated on a calendar month basis, with the Company redelivering the gas to the customer on an as needed basis. A customer selecting the Balancing Service Option shall be required to pay the Balancing Fee as set forth in 2(D) below.
