##### D. Pipeline Supplier Adjustment (PSA):

The charges set forth herein will be subject to a PSA per Therm of gas delivered as explained in Section 15 of PSC No. 90 Gas, or superseding issues thereof.

##### E. Transition Surcharge (TS):

Customers in all areas initiating service after November 2, 1995 will also be charged the applicable Transition Surcharge (TS) pursuant to General Information Section 18 of PSC No. 90 Gas, or superseding issues thereof, for all therm use.
