## 4. DAILY METERED TRANSPORTATION REQUIREMENTS: (CONT'D)

## R. Capacity Surcharge(s):

Designated Agents of daily metered transportation customers, or customers acting on their own behalf, in the Goshen Area, Champlain Area, Plattsburgh District and Mechanicville District shall be assessed a capacity surcharge. The capacity surcharge will reflect the costs incurred by the Company to transport Customers supplies on intermediary local distribution companies and intrastate pipelines.

## S. Voluntary Capacity Assignment:

Customers or Designated Agents may voluntarily take assignment of the Company's available upstream storage and transportation capacity.

If the assigned capacity has a lower (higher) cost than the weighted average cost of capacity for the applicable rate area, as calculated and filed with the PSC on a monthly basis, the Customer or their designated agent shall receive a surcharge (credit) for the difference between the assigned capacity cost and the Company's weighted average capacity cost.

Capacity shall be assigned to transportation Customers or their Designated Agents to achieve minimal impact on remaining sales Customers. Such assignments shall be for successive one (1) year terms so long as the Company continues to have operationally available capacity. The capacity assigned shall be recallable.
