- b. Interim Recovery of FERC Order 636 Transition Costs - All volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed a surcharge calculated according to the New York State Public Service Commission's Opinion and Order Establishing Regulatory Policies and Guidelines for Natural Gas Distributors, Opinion 94-26 in Case 93-G-0932, issued and effective December 20, 1994. The FERC Order 636 Transition Costs will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- c. All volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed the Credit/Surcharge for Interruptible and Firm Dual Fuel Sales and Transportation Service Benefits as determined in General Information Section 12. The Credit/Surcharge for Interruptible and Firm Dual Fuel Sales and Transportation Service Benefits will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Service Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- d. During the period October 1 through May 31 of each year, all volumes of gas used under this Service Classification shall be assessed the Weather Normalization Adjustment pursuant to General Information Section 12.3.
- e. All volumes used under this Service Classification shall be assessed a surcharge for stranded costs as determined in General Information Section 12. The surcharge will be shown as a separate line item in the Statement of Adjustments to Firm Transportation Rates as filed with the Commission each month.
- f. All rates and charges under this Service Classification will be increased pursuant to General Information Section 15.

STATEMENT OF ADJUSTMENTS TO FIRM TRANSPORTATION SERVICE RATES:

Not less than three working days prior to the first day of each billing period, the Company shall file with the Commission a statement showing the adjustments to firm transportation charges, as provided for above.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

Bills are due when rendered, subject to a late payment charge in accordance with the provisions of General Information Section 6.7.
