All gas delivered under this Service Classification shall be subject to a surcharge per 100 cubic feet as set forth in Section 38, General Information.
  - d. Upstream and Intermediate Pipeline Transition Surcharge  
All gas delivered under this Service Classification shall be subject to a surcharge per 100 cubic feet as described in General Information Section 42 and 42A.
  - e. Research and Development (R&D) Surcharge  
All gas delivered under this Service Classification shall be subject to the R & D surcharge per 100 cubic feet described in General Information Section 43.
  - f. Transition Costs Associated with FERC Order No. 636  
All gas delivered under this Service Classification shall be subject to the monthly Order No. 636 transition cost surcharge per 100 cubic feet as described in General Information Section 19.k.
  - g. Reserve Capacity Cost Adjustment  
All gas delivered under this Service Classification shall be subject to the Reserve Capacity Cost Adjustment charge per 100 cubic feet as described in General Information Section 19.b.(1)(a)ii.
3. Weather Normalization Adjustment  
All gas delivered under this Service Classification shall be subject to a refund/surcharge per 100 cubic feet as set forth in Section 36, General Information.

MONTHLY COST OF GAS:

In addition to the above delivery service charges Customers purchasing their gas supply service from the Company will pay the Monthly Gas Supply Charges per 100 cubic feet of gas supplied by the Company as explained in General Information Section 19.b.(1)(b).

INCREMENTAL MONTHLY COST OF GAS:

Under special circumstances when transportation customers return from Marketers to sales service under periods of rising prices the Company may, at its discretion, establish a incremental Monthly Gas Supply Charge to be billed to the returning Customers. Notice of such rate shall be published in a monthly statement as appropriate.
