- (2) The Company shall notify post March 30, 1983 applicants for new or additional service that are required to install dual-fuel facilities hereunder of their first curtailment status. The Company shall also notify such applicants that they may be required to leave the line in order for the Company to serve existing higher priority customers. An applicant shall be required to sign a statement or agreement acknowledging the service limitations set forth in this Paragraph.
- (3) The following special terms and conditions apply to applicants for gas service for emergency electric generation (hereafter "EEG").
 - (a) The customer shall only install sufficient EEG capacity to provide the minimum needs for safety and health.
 - (b) The customer shall pay all costs associated with the installation including, if necessary, all costs for system reinforcement, mains, and service laterals.
 - (c) In the event that the Commission places restrictions on the Company's sale of gas to its customers, the Company will penalize EEG customers for excessive usage. Excessive usage will occur when the customer exceeds his existing annual limitation for other uses plus an annual EEG allotment allowing one-half hour testing each week and estimated use during verifiable power outages.
