C. <u>Distributed Generation Interconnection Requirements</u> (cont'd)

B. <u>DG Application Process:</u>

- (1) Applications will be processed in accordance with the relevant sections of the New York State Standardized Interconnection Requirements for Distributed Generators Rated 300 kVA or Less, Connected in Parallel with Radial Distribution Lines, as the same may be revised, modified, amended, clarified, supplemented or superseded, and which is incorporated herein by reference. The pertinent application steps are set forth below.
- (2) The Customer is required to make application to the Company, using a form substantially in the form of, New York State Standardized Application for Single Phase Interconnection of Distributed Generation Equipment Rated 15 kVA or Less, Connected to Parallel with the Central Hudson System, or New York State Standardized Application for Interconnection Generation Equipment Rated 300 kVA or Less, Connected in Parallel with CHG&E System, which are included in Section G herein.

C. <u>DG Standardized Contract:</u>

- (1) Customer is required to enter into a signed Contract with Central Hudson substantially in the form of, New York State Standardized Contract for Interconnection of Distributed Generation Units with Capacity of 300 kVA or less to be Connected in Parallel with Radial Distribution Lines.
- (2) Termination of the Contract by either party will be in accordance with the Contract Section 1.2 Termination.

D. <u>DG Interconnection Requirements:</u>

(1) DG Interconnection Requirements will be in accordance with the relevant sections of Central Hudson's Requirements for Independent Power Producers of Electricity pertaining to the New York State Standardized Interconnection Requirements for Distributed Generators Rated 300 kVA or Less, Connected with Radial Distribution Lines.
