- Transportation Customer Billing Options (2)(Cont'd.)
 - Customer Choice of Billing Option (Cont'd.) (A)
 - The billing party chosen by the customer will be responsible 1. for the following functions:
 - a. printing and mailing consolidated bills;
 - printing standard bill messages and forwarding standard b. bill inserts;
 - receiving and processing payments; C
 - d. apportioning and remitting the non-billing party's portion of accounts collected; and
 - e. providing payment details by account to non-billing party.
 - 2. Customers receiving both electric and gas services from the Company ("dual-service customers") may elect different Marketers to provide their electric and gas supply requirements. A customer may elect to receive a single bill from the Company or one of the Marketers designated as the billing party by the customer, if the Marketers mutually agree to the billing option chosen. If the Marketers do not agree on the billing option, or if the customer chooses to receive separate bills for each service, upon the Marketer's request and payment of an Account Separation Fee of \$32.50, the dualservice account will be separated into separate accounts.
 - A customer may choose to change billing options by having the Marketer notify the Company, or by switching to a Marketer that offers the billing option requested by the customer. The change will be effective on the first of the following calendar month provided that the Company has received at least 10 calendar days prior notice. A Marketer is not required to offer the Marketer Single Bill in order to participate in the Company's Gas Transportation Service Program.
