D. Default and Remedies: (Cont'd)

(1) Events of Default by ESCO/Marketer: (Cont'd)

- (iv) failure to properly maintain the Lockbox or other account required or established as part of an Alternative Billing Arrangement; or
 - (v) failure in the performance of any other material covenant, condition or provision of this Schedule to be performed by the ESCO/Marketer where such default continues unremedied for a period of fifteen (15) calendar days after written notice from the Company specifying the nature of such default, or, if the default cannot reasonably be cured within fifteen (15) calendar days of such notice, such default shall occur if the ESCO/Marketer has not diligently commenced and pursued the cure within fifteen (15) calendar days of such notice.
- (b) Additional detail regarding Default and Remedies can be found in the applicable Billing Services Agreement.

E. Election:

(1) Initiating a Billing Arrangement:

- (a) A Customer must notify the ESCO/Marketer of its choice to:
 - (i) initiate an Alternative Billing Arrangement; or
 - (ii) select another Alternative Billing Arrangementas more fully set forth in the Gas Transportation Operating Procedures Manual.
- (b) If a Customer chooses to return to Dual Billing, such Customer may notify either the Company or the ESCO/Marketer.
- (c) The Customer's election of a billing arrangement (Single/Consolidated Bill or Dual Bill) must be submitted to the Company prior to the billing arrangement effective date as follows:
