GENERAL INFORMATION

59. Electric Vehicle Direct Current Fast Charging Surcharge ("EV DCFC")

59.1 The EV DCFC Surcharge is a surcharge to recover costs associated with the implementation of the Company's EV DCFC Incentive Program.

59.2 The EV DCFC Surcharge will be applicable to a customer's kWh usage that is not subject to the System Benefits Charge ("SBC") per Rule 41. Specifically, this includes deliveries of power from the New York Power Authority under Service Classification No. 4, deliveries of Recharge New York ("RNY") power per Rule 34, deliveries of qualifying Empire Zone Rider ("EZR") power per Rule 34, and SBC exempt deliveries under Service Classification No. 12 in accordance with their contracts.

59.3 The EV DCFC Surcharge will be applied to applicable customers' bills beginning January 1, 2020 and through December 31, 2020.

59.4 The EV DCFC Surcharge rate shall be set at \$0.00026 per kWh, which is the Company's maximum EV DCFC total program costs of \$9,000,000, divided by the Company's forecasted total annual kWh deliveries for calendar year 2020.
