F. Supply Service Options

Pursuant to General Information Section 25, Supply Service Options, a customer shall choose its supply service option. Customers in the program must choose a Retail Access rate or a Non-Retail Access rate.

- 1. The Retail Access choice is the ESCO Supply Service (ESS). Supply Service shall be provided by an Energy Services Company (ESCO).
 - a. Bills for S.C. Nos. 1, 6, 8, and 12 customers taking service under the Retail Access Choice shall include: the Customer Charge, the Bill Issuance Charge, On-Peak and Off-Peak delivery charges. Customers that elect ESS and receive a Consolidated Bill shall not be subject to the Bill Issuance Charge.
 - b. Bills for S.C. Nos. 2, 3P, 7-1, 7-2, and 7-3 customers taking service under the Retail Access Choice shall include: the customer charge, the Bill Issuance Charge, meter ownership charge, meter service charge, meter data service charge, all-hour delivery charge (not applicable to S.C. Nos. 7-1, 7-2, and 7-3), reactive demand charge, and either the summer On-Peak delivery charge, or the non-summer demand charge; and; the NBC. Customers that elect ESS and receive a Consolidated Bill shall not be subject to the Bill Issuance Charge.
- 2. The Non-Retail Access choice is the Company Hourly Pricing. Electricity supply is provided by the Company.
 - a. Bills for S.C. Nos. 1, 6, 8, and 12 customers taking service under the Company hourly pricing shall include: the customer charge, a Bill Issuance Charge, On-Peak and Off-Peak delivery charges, the NBC, the Merchant Function Charge, and a commodity charge for electricity supply as described in General Information Section 25.I.C.3, Calculation of the Commodity Charge for Hourly Pricing.
 - b. Bills for S.C. Nos. 2, 3P, 7-1, 7-2, and 7-3 customers taking service under the Company Hourly Pricing shall include: the customer charge, a Bill Issuance Charge, meter ownership charge, meter service charge, meter data service charge, all-hour delivery charge (not applicable to S.C Nos. 7-1, 7-2, and 7-3), reactive demand charge, and either the summer On-Peak delivery charge, or non-summer demand charge, a NBC, the Merchant Function Charge, and a commodity charge for electricity supply as described in General Information Section 25.I.C.3, Calculation of the Commodity Charge for Hourly Pricing.
