A Seller/Direct Customer shall not be subject to a Surplus or Deficiency Imbalance Charge on any day in which the Daily Delivery Quantity is less (surplus imbalance) or more (deficiency imbalance) than the corresponding Daily Transportation Quantity (less the allowance for losses).

Daily Imbalance Charges shall not be applicable during an OFO period, during which the Seller is subject to Charges for Unauthorized Use.
