# NATURAL GAS MOTOR VEHICLES

### APPLICABLE TO THE USE OF SERVICE FOR:

Service to any customer (already taking service under another service classification) for the sole purpose of fueling natural gas motor vehicles. Service shall be metered separately from all other service taken and is subject to restrictions as provided in the Special Provisions herein.

Service is also available on a first come, first serve basis at compressor stations owned and operated by the Company and located at Company facilities and is subject to restrictions provided in the Special Provisions herein.

# **CHARACTER OF SERVICE:**

Continuous - for customers in Categories 1, 2 and 4 below, natural gas or a mixture of natural gas and synthetic natural gas with not less than 950 Btu per cubic foot for all districts. For gas compressed by the Customer on their premises, normal pressure shall be not less than 4" water column. For gas compressed by the Company, the maximum delivery pressure shall be provided in accordance with the NFPA-52 standards and customer requirements.

Interruptible - for customers in Category 3 below, natural gas or a mixture of natural gas and synthetic natural gas with a Btu content of not less than 950 Btu per cubic foot for all districts. For gas compressed by the Customer on their premises, normal pressure shall be not less than 4" water column. For gas compressed by the Company, the maximum delivery pressure shall be provided in accordance with the NFPA-52 standards and customer requirements. Customers may take service under this category when the Company has facilities available and adequate for the load.
