GENERAL INFORMATION

23. Community Distributed Generation

7. Annual Allocation Requests

- a. Once a year, following the annual anniversary of the CDG Host, after the CDG Host and all CDG satellite accounts have billed and credits allocated in accordance with Section 6, the Company shall supply the CDG Host any excess credits returned to the CDG Host and/or any unallocated excess credits remaining at the CDG Host. Within 30 days of receipt of such information, the CDG Host must furnish to the Company an annual allocation request for distributing these excess credits.
 - i. No distribution shall be made if an annual allocation request is not received by the required date, and any undistributed credits on the CDG Host shall be forfeited.
 - ii. As described in subparagraph a., above, any excess credits are to be distributed to the CDG Satellites, as such there shall be no annual cash-out for: non-residential customers that have Farm Wind or Farm Waste electric generating equipment.

8. Account Closure

- a. The Company shall require an actual meter reading to close a CDG Host Account or CDG Satellite Account taking service pursuant to CDG.
- b. The Company shall close an account on the earlier of: (a) the first cycle date on which a reading is taken following the requested turn off date, or (b) the date of a special reading, which a Customer may request at the charge specified in Charges for Special Services Statement.
- c. After a CDG Host customer's final bill is rendered, any remaining credit shall not be transferred. A CDG Host with Farm Wind or Farm Waste electric generating equipment shall receive a final cash out at avoided cost.
- d. A CDG Satellite Account shall no longer receive credits after the final bill is rendered on its account. Any remaining credit at the CDG Satellite Account shall be transferred back to the CDG Host.

9. Liability

Notwithstanding any other provision of this tariff, in case the supply of service shall be interrupted or irregular or defective or fail from causes beyond the Company's control (including without limiting the generality of the foregoing executive or administrative rules or orders issued from time to time by State or Federal officers, commissions, boards or bodies having jurisdiction), or because of the ordinary negligence of the Company, its employees, servants or agents, the Company will not be liable therefore.
