- (10) **Deficiency Imbalance** means:
  - (a) for Interruptible Daily Balancing Service and Monthly Balancing Service, the amount by which the Daily Transportation Quantity ("DTQ"), exclusive of the allowance for losses, and adjusted for marketer imbalance trading, is less than the Customer's Daily Delivery Quantity, and
  - (b) for Daily Delivery Service, the amount by which the Customer's DTQ, exclusive of the allowance for losses, and adjusted for marketer imbalance trading, is less than the Customer's Daily Delivery Service Quantity.

The deficiency imbalance shall be increased to allow for losses.

For a small customer aggregation group or a group aggregating imbalances, one deficiency imbalance shall be determined for the entire group.
