- (K) Reclosers and Single Phasing - The Company practices reclosing. Lines may trip and close several times during a single disturbance. Closing may occur as quickly as 0.2 seconds or as late as five minutes following a trip. Fused circuit laterals are common on rural distribution circuits. Fused laterals increase the possibility of single-phasing. Although these reclosing and fusing practices place no additional requirements on the interconnection, the customer should consider additional protection for the generator.

**TERM OF SERVICE**

Unless otherwise directed by the Commission, there is no end-date to the term of service under this Rider for:

- (A) customers with non-wind electric generating equipment that was in service as of March 9, 2017;
- (B) customers with non-wind electric generating equipment that was not in service as of March 9, 2017, provided that both: (1) Step 4 of the SIR was completed for generation rated 50 kW or less as of March 9, 2017 or Step 8 of the SIR was completed for generation rated above 50 kW as of March 9, 2017; and (2) the Company received written notification of complete installation by March 17, 2017; and
- (C) customers with wind electric generating equipment, up to an aggregate of 3.1 MW of wind generating capacity served under this Rider.

The term of service under this Rider is 20 years from the in-service date for all other customers, except for RNM customers receiving monetary crediting under (C)(7) of the Billing Section of this Rider. The term of service for these customers is 25 years from the later of April 17, 2015, or the project in-service date.

At the end of the term of service, customers with on-site generation, RNM Host and RNM Satellite Accounts, and CDG Host and CDG Satellite Accounts will forfeit any remaining net metering credit that remains.
