2. HOW TO OBTAIN SERVICE (Cont'd)

F. LIMITATIONS OF SERVICE OFFER – Residential and Non-Residential

(1) **General**

The Company's offer(s) of electric service included in and made pursuant to the provisions of the Schedule and the service classifications to which it relates, including its offers in respect to extension of facilities, Rule 3.A, are each subject to and modified by the provisions, conditions and limitations from time to time imposed by executive or administrative rules or orders issued from time to time by state or federal officers, commissions, boards or bodies having jurisdiction.

(2) **Minimum Insulation Standards for the Provision of Electric Service**

(a) **Definitions**

For the purpose of this rule, the following definitions shall apply:

- (i) Dwelling - A building designed or used as the living unit for one or more families. Mobile homes shall not be considered dwellings.
- (ii) Historical Building - Any building or structure designated historically significant by the State or local governing body, or listed (or determined by the Secretary of the Interior to be eligible to be listed) in "The National Register of Historic Places."
