(6) Minimum Insulation Standards for the Provision of Gas Service (Cont'd)

(j) Penalties for Non-Compliance

The Company shall impose a 25 percent surcharge on any bill for gas service to any dwelling which has been converted to gas heat and which does not comply with the standards set forth in Rule 2.F.6.g.

The effective date of the surcharge rate shall be:

- (i) Immediately after notice, in the event the owner is directly responsible for the non-compliance.
- (ii) Ninety days after notice, in the event the owner has not contributed to the deficiencies. No surcharge shall be applied if the owner brings the dwelling into compliance within 90 days.

In the event the owner is not billed for the provision of gas service, no surcharges will be applied to the bills of the non-owner occupants of the dwelling. Instead, after notification to the owner that the dwelling is not in compliance, a surcharge will be billed to the owner. The surcharge will be 25 percent of the gas bills for the dwelling that is not in compliance.
