GENERAL INFORMATION - Continued

Site Investigation and Remediation (SIR) Recovery Surcharge

The Company shall recover deferred site investigation remediation costs as identified in the Commission's Order in Case 06-G-1186, dated November 28, 2012, through a volumetric surcharge. This surcharge is unitized for each service class based upon the forecasted percentage of each service classification's contribution to total firm delivery revenues.

The surcharges effective January 1, 2014 are listed below:

System Benefits Charge

As of January 2008, and annually thereafter until the Commission orders otherwise, a System Benefits Charge (SBC) will recover costs associated with the Company's energy efficiency programs. Such costs, including program costs and lost revenue, are recoverable through the SBC pursuant to the Commission's Orders in Case 06-G-1186. Effective January 1, 2010, lost revenues will not be recovered for Service Classification Nos. 1B, 1BR, 1B-DG, 5-1B and 5-1BR.

The Company will calculate the SBC by dividing the annual energy efficiency dollars, plus (minus) any over or undercollections from prior years, including carrying charges, by the projected volumes from the following firm service classifications: 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 5, 15, and 16.

The SBC will appear on the Statement of System Benefits Charge. Except for the Statement of System Benefits Charge filed to be effective January 1, 2010, the Statement of System Benefits Charge will be filed on no less than 15 days notice.

Delivery Rate Adjustment

The Delivery Rate Adjustment (DRA) will apply to all customers being served under Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, 5, 9, 10, 15, 16 and 17. The DRA will appear as a separate line item on the customer's bill.

The DRA will consist of a weather normalization adjustment applicable to certain heating customers (as explained on Leaf Nos. 78 and 79) and a delivery rate surcharge (as explained above).
