XXIX. LIABILITY: (Cont'd.)

B. Customer's Equipment:

Neither by inspection or non-rejection, nor in any other way, does the Company give any warranty, expressed or implied, as to the adequacy, safety or other characteristics of any structures, equipment, wires, pipes, appliances or devices owned, installed or maintained by the Customer or leased by the Customer from third parties.

C. Company Equipment and Use of Service:

The Company will not be liable for any injury, casualty or damage resulting in any way from the supply or use of gas or from the presence or operation of the Company's structures, equipment, wires, pipes, appliances or devices on the Customer's premises, except injuries or damages resulting from the negligence of the Company.

XXX. RATE REVISIONS:

In the event of any change or revisions of this schedule made in regular and legal manner, all consumers previously taking service under this schedule will be billed thereafter in accordance with the revised, superseding or substituting schedules so established. In case said change effects an increase in the charge for service, any such consumer will have the option of discontinuing his service without further liability for the unexpired term.

XXI. CHANGE IN INSTALLATION:

The consumer should notify the Utilities Commission when increasing the connected load, preferably in writing, so that the Utilities Commission's equipment may be checked for adequacy.
