**SERVICE CLASSIFICATION NO. 2 (Cont'd)****GENERAL SERVICE - SMALL USE****SPECIAL PROVISIONS:**1. Change of Service Classification

The Company shall install a demand measuring device and provide service under Service Classification No. 7 - General Service - 12 kW Minimum:

- a. Whenever it is determined that the customer is using, or might use, more than 12 kW of billing demand, or
- b. Whenever the customer's consumption during the preceding 12 months has exceeded 3,000 kWh in each of four consecutive monthly billing periods, or 6,000 kWh in two bi-monthly billing periods.

## B. Excelsior Jobs Program (EJP)

Service taken under this Service Classification may be eligible for the rates and charges under the Excelsior Jobs Program.

For a customer qualifying for the EJP program, such customer shall be subject to the otherwise applicable standard service classification rates, including the Monthly Adjustment Clause, Commodity, Merchant Function, and Bill Issuance Charges, if applicable, in accordance with the standard RSS or ESS rates for this Service Classification. All customers are also required to pay the System Benefits Charges, Renewable Portfolio Standard, Temporary State Assessment Surcharge, and in accordance with the standard RSS or ESS rates for this Service Classification. Qualifying load shall be exempt from the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism (RDM).
