**RE: Case 17-G-0794, Reconciliation of Purchase of Receivables**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) the following Statement of Purchase of Receivables (“POR”) Discount Percentage to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the “Gas Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

DISC - Statement of POR Discount Percentage No. 1 to P.S.C No. 9 – Gas  
The Statement is being issued to become effective on January 1, 2019.

**Reason for Filing**

In compliance with the Commission’s Order Modifying Reconciliation of Gas Purchase of Receivables, issued and effective July 13, 2018, in Case 17-G-0794 (the “Order”), the Company’s compliance filing made on September 26, 2018 modified the manner in which credit and collections and theft (“C&C”) recoveries for retail access customers served by Energy Service Companies (“ESCOs”) that participate in the Purchase of Receivables program are reconciled.

The Company is filing the first Statement of POR Discount Percentage to the Gas Tariff. The Statement of POR Discount Percentage shows the Uncollectible Bill Percentage, Risk Factor, Credit & Collections, and Incremental Cost components of the POR Discount Percentage. The total POR Discount Percentage, effective January 1, 2019, is 3.37%. In accordance with the Company’s compliance filing, the Company is filing its Statement of POR Discount Percentage on no less than three days before its effective date.
