Re: Proposed Tariff Revisions – General Housekeeping

Dear Secretary Burgess:

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“Distribution” or the “Company”) hereby submits the following revisions to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS:

By way of background, this is a filing to make general housekeeping corrections to tables appearing on Leaf 129 and Leaf 132, of the Company’s tariff. These proposed changes will help the Company maintain the “belt and suspenders” approach currently employed within Distribution’s tariff structure. These changes have a proposed initial effective date of March 1, 2019.

Specifically, the proposed revision to Leaf 129 adds the System Modernization Tracker and the Weather Normalization Adjustment to the table appearing in section B. (1). The System Modernization Tracker is currently effective and is described in detail on Leaf 120 of Distribution’s tariff. Similarly, the Weather Normalization Adjustment is currently effective and is described in detail on Leaf 122 of the Company’s tariff. The proposed revision to Leaf 129 aims to fully complete the table appearing in section B. (1).

Furthermore, the proposed revision to Leaf 132 adds the System Modernization Tracker and the Weather Normalization Adjustment to the table appearing under the “Miscellaneous Charges and Fees” section. The proposed revision to Leaf 132 also aims to fully complete a table contained in Distribution’s tariff.

It should be further noted that Leaf 129, Revision No. 2 is currently pending, with an effective date of 12/1/2018, in compliance with Case No. 14-M-0565 regarding the Company’s low income implementation plans. However, this proposed tariff revision is completely separate and unrelated to Case 14-M-0565.

Concurrent with this filing, Distribution respectfully requests a waiver from the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1, pertaining to newspaper publication. The proposed tariff changes are being made for consistency and clarification purposes, the revisions are largely non-substantive in customer effect, and therefore the expense of publication would not serve the public interest.
