In accordance with Section 720-2 et al. of the Commission's regulations, 16 NYCRR § 720-2 et al., Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("Company") submits the following tariff leaves to become effective May 1, 2019:

To Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. 219-GAS

Effective: 05/01/2019

The purpose of this filing is to amend the tariff leaves that were filed on July 12, 2018 relative to Service Classification No. 11 – Load Aggregation ("SC 11") ("July 12 Filing"). The leaves pertain to the Company's capacity release program that was set forth in the Joint Proposal adopted by the Commission in its *Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plans* (issued and effective March 15, 2018) in Cases 17-E-0238 and 17-G-0239 (the "Order"). Under the program, gas marketers/ESCOs would be provided with a pro-rata share of all of the Company's gas supply assets (*i.e.*, provide a "slice of the system"), commencing in the winter of CY 2018/19.

In its July 12 Filing, the Company inadvertently failed to include references to the other pipelines in the Company's portfolio. Currently, the tariff only references Dominion Energy Transmission, Inc. ("DTI"). The amended tariff leaves included here correct this oversight.

In addition, the Company is adding language specifying minimum delivery requirements that was not previously included. Finally, the amended leaves clarify a definition applicable to SC 11.

Attachment 1 of this filing contains the redlined tariff leaves showing the proposed revisions and Attachment 2 contains a pro forma Statement of Demand Transfer Recovery showing the proposed revisions.

The Company requests a waiver of the newspaper publication requirement under Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720.8.

In accordance with Section 720-2.3 of the Commission's regulations, a proposed notice of this filing suitable for use under the State Administrative Procedure Act is also enclosed.
