The enclosed addenda, issued by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”), (together the “Companies”) are transmitted for filing in compliance with the New York Public Service Commission’s (the “Commission”) Order Modifying Standardized Interconnection Requirements (the “Order”), issued and effective October 18, 2018, in the above-referenced proceeding. The addenda will become effective November 2, 2018.

Purpose of Filing

The Companies are filing revised Standard Interconnection Requirements (“SIR”) in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order.

Revisions to the SIR include advising developers that they shall submit their as-built drawings to the Companies prior to the initiation of the final cost reconciliation. The reconciliation process has been updated to clarify that developers are charged only for the Companies’ actual costs incurred after the initial application review, for which the fixed application fee provides

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compensation. Other updates have been incorporated into SIR Appendix K that clarifies the process to request changes in the operating characteristics of an interconnected Energy Storage System, and SIR Appendix G to include explicit Pass/Fail criteria for Preliminary Screening.


Newspaper Publication
