Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. The revised addendum, which is identified below, has an effective date of November 1, 2018.

Reason for Filing and Tariff Changes

The Commission in its Order Modifying Standardized Interconnection Requirements, issued and effective October 18, 2018, in Case 18-E-0018 (the “Order”), among other things, directed the major electric utilities to incorporate into their electric tariffs the revised Standardized Interconnection Requirements (“SIR”) as shown in Appendix A of the Order, and to remove any inconsistent tariff provisions. Pursuant to the Order, the Company is filing the Commission’s revised SIR as Tariff Addendum SIR-12.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, Addendum SIR-12 is being filed on not less than one day’s notice, to become effective on November 1, 2018. As specified in

Ordering Clause 3 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
