Temperature Control Interruptible Revenue Reconciliation for Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Brooklyn Union Gas Company, d/b/a National Grid (“the Company”) hereby submits its Statement of Temperature Control Interruptible Revenue Reconciliation Surcharge/Credit No. 1 (“Statement”) in compliance with Rule 52 of PSC No. 12 Gas Tariff. The Company has performed a reconciliation of its Temperature Control and Interruptible revenues for the period January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

Effective March 1, 2018 through February 28, 2019, the following Temperature Control Interruptible Revenue Reconciliation Surcharge/Credit will be implemented:

- Service Classification Nos. 1A, 1AR, 1B, 1BI, 1BR, 1B-DG, 2-1, 2-2, 3, 4A, 4A-CNG, 4B, 7, 17 and 21: \$.0045 per therm.
