Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison") is filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") amendments to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Tariff"), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The Company's tariff leaves, identified below, are issued to become effective on December 1, 2017.

Reason for Filing

The Commission in its Order Approving Tariff Amendments on a Permanent Basis and Directing Further Modifications, issued November 20, 2017, in Cases 16-E-0060, 16-G-0061 and 16-E-0196 (the "Order"), directed the Company to file tariff amendments consistent with the proposed tariff language in the Company's March 15, 2017 reply comments that were submitted in response to various parties' comments to the January 31, 2017 tariff amendments filed by the Company.

Tariff Changes

Pursuant to the Order, the Company is filing tariff changes as described below:

- "All or part of" from "all or part of the reconnection charge" has been removed in General Rule 15.2 of the Tariff (Leaf 119).

- General Rule 20.2.2 of the Tariff has been corrected to state 20.2.3 for Common Provisions (Leaf 160).
- Clarifying language has been added to General Rule 20.3.2(c) of the Tariff (Leaf 162) to state that customers with Designated Technologies will meet additional requirements specified in General Rule 20.3.4(a).

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Company is filing changes to the Tariff to become effective on December 1, 2017. As specified in Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
