Effective: January 1, 2018

On February 17, 2017, the above Order was issued by the Commission approving the utilities lowincome implementation plans with certain modifications. This Order directed the utilities to file tariff amendments implementing the provisions of this order on no less than two days' notice to become effective on April 1, 2017.

On March 27, 2017, the Company issued a letter to the Secretary of the Commission requesting an extension of the April 1, 2017 filing date to December 1, 2017 to file the tariff amendments implementing the provisions discussed in the Order. This request by the Company was made to avoid customer confusion as the new rates would not become effective until January 1, 2018. On March 29, 2017, the Secretary of the Commission granted this request extending the filing of these tariff revisions to December 1, 2017. The attached leaves comply with this directive.

Ordering Clause No. 3 of this order waived the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) as to newspaper publication of the changes included with this filing.

The attachment included with this filing contains redlined leaves showing the revisions to this filing.
