In accordance with the Public Service Commission of the State of New York's ("Commission") Order Adopting Gas Rate Plans For The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY ("Company") issued on December 16, 2016 in Case 16-G-0059 ("December 16 Order") and other applicable Rules and Regulations, the Company hereby submits one copy of the revised tariff leaves listed in Appendix A to its Schedule for Gas Service, PSC No. 12 to become effective on a temporary basis on January 1, 2018. The purpose of the filing is to implement the Rate Year 2 rates as directed by Ordering Paragraph 6 of the December 16 Order.

Additionally, in accordance with the Commission's Order Approving Implementation Plans with Modifications issued on February 17, 2017 in Case 14-M-0565 ("February 17 Order"), the Company submits its filing to implement the new Energy Affordability Program. The February 17, 2017 Order approved the Company's low-income implementation plan, and implementation plans of other utilities, with certain modifications and directed utilities to file tariff amendments implementing Energy Affordability Programs on no less than two days' notice to become effective on April 1, 2017. On March 27, 2017, the Company filed a letter with the Commission Secretary requesting an extension of the April 1, 2017 filing date to December 1, 2017 to file the required tariff amendments to avoid customer confusion because the new rates would not become effective until January 1, 2018. On March 29, 2017, the Commission Secretary granted the request and extended the filing deadline to December 1, 2017. The Company's tariff amendments to implement its Energy Affordability Program hereby are submitted with this filing to become effective on January 1, 2018.
