Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) hereby submits for filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) revised tariff leaves and Addendum UBP-DERS-1 to its Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric tariff”).

The tariff leaves set forth below and Addendum UBP-DERS-1 are issued November 16, 2017, to become effective on December 1, 2017.

Reason for Filing

The Company is making this filing pursuant to the Commission’s Order Establishing Oversight Framework and Uniform Business Practices for Distributed

Energy Resource Suppliers (the “October Order”) issued and effective October 19, 2017, in the above-referenced case.

Ordering Clause 2 of the October Order directed the utilities to file revisions to their tariffs to incorporate the Uniform Business Practices for Distributed Energy Resource Suppliers (“UBP-DERS”), and to add the UBP-DERS as an addendum to their tariffs, on not less than 15 days’ notice to become effective December 1, 2017.

Summary of Tariff Changes

Changes to the Company’s Electric tariff are described below:

- The Company has added the UBP-DERS as an addendum to the Electric tariff (“Addendum-UBP-DERS”). In addition, “Addendum-UBP-DERS” was added to the Table of Contents.
- The Company modified the "Definition and Abbreviations of Terms Used in this Rate Schedule" section to include the term “Uniform Business Practices – Distributed Energy Resource Suppliers” and the abbreviation “UBP-DERS.”
- The Company modified the Applicability section of Rider R – Net Metering and Value Stack Tariff for Customer-Generators to include the requirement in the October Order that distribution generation providers making interconnection requests on or after December 1, 2017, for Community Distributed Generation (“CDG”) projects and On-Site Mass Market Customer projects must submit proof to the Company with their initial interconnection applications that their projects have been registered with Department of Public Service Staff in accordance with the UBP-DERS.
- The Remote Net Metering and Community Distributed Generation Section of Rider R currently states that the Company’s CDG Program Procedural Requirements sets forth consumer protections required of CDG Hosts until such time that the Commission establishes the UBP for Distributed Energy Resource Providers. This provision was modified to state that these consumer protections are also contained in the UBP-DERS.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 2 of the October Order, the Company is filing changes to the Electric tariff to become effective on December 1, 2017. As specified in Ordering Clause 6 of the October Order, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
