RE: Pole Attachment Rates – Tariff Filing

Dear Secretary Burgess,

Enclosed herewith are the following materials, issued and transmitted for filing on behalf of the City of Jamestown Board of Public Utilities ("JBPU"), in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission ("Commission").

1. Revised tariff leaf for P.S.C. No. 7, Electricity, containing provisions for pole attachment rates:

Leaf No.91, Revision 2

The JBPU is proposing to amend its tariff to update the rates it charges cable television operators to attach to JBPU owned poles. The JBPU is updating its pole attachment rates in accordance with the Commission's *Order Approving Municipal Pole Attachment Rate Increase with Modification*, issued August 4, 2017 in Case 17-E-0243. The JBPU currently charges \$8.51 per pole for its pole attachment charges pursuant to Commission's *Order on Municipal Pole Attachment Rates* issued on May 9, 2007 in Case 06-E-1427. The Commission, in Case 17-E-0243, ordered that "[a]ll municipal electric companies are authorized to file tariff amendments, on not less than one day's notice, containing an annual pole attachment rate of \$11.98."<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, the JBPU is filing a revised tariff leaf to increase its pole attachment rate from \$8.51 per pole to \$11.98 per pole as described in Leaf 91, Revision 2. This amendment is issued as of September 11, 2017 and proposed to become effective September 12, 2017.

The JBPU respectfully requests a waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL § 66(12)(b) as authorized by Ordering paragraph 2 of the Commission's August 4, 2017 Order in Case 17-E-0243.<sup>2</sup>

Accordingly, we respectfully request that the Commission expedite approval of the requested tariff revision.
