Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or "the Company") is filing today with the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission") Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge No. 8, effective April 1, 2017.

Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge No. 8
for Service Classification Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 9

Explanation of Filing

The Company recovers or refunds any delivery revenue under- or over- collections resulting from the extension of the suspension period in Case 16-G-0061¹ through the Delivery Revenue Surcharge ("DRS"). The Statement of DRS No. 7, filed on February 24, 2017, effective March 1, 2017, established the DRS for each customer group, with the exception of the Service Classification ("SC") 2 "re-class" customers.

This filing establishes the DRS for the SC 2 "re-class" customers and updates the DRS for the SC 2 customer groups, "excluding re-class customers".² These re-class customers are those that have moved between SC 2 Rate I and Rate II due to the change in the applicability criteria, as explained in Section H.2.a. of the Joint Proposal adopted in the Rate Order. The DRS rates, effective April 1, 2017, for the SC 2 Rate I and SC 2 Rate II customer groups, i.e. "excluding re-class" and "re-class" customer groups, are the same prior to the inclusion of the DRS for the weather normalization adjustments. The DRS for the SC 2 re-class customers also includes over- or under- collections related to the weather normalization adjustments.

The Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge No. 8 will be effective beginning April 1, 2017.

Summary

The DRS for the SC 2 Rate I and SC 2 Rate II customer groups reflects a delivery revenue net under-collection of \$2,458,512, consisting of: an over-collection of \$2,322,137 related to SC 2 Rate I customers; an under-collection of \$4,961,087 related to SC 2 Rate II customers; and a net over-collection of \$180,438 related to weather normalization adjustments for the SC 2 re-class customers.
