In accordance with the requirement of Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Commission's *Order on Net Energy Metering Transition, Phase One of Value of Distributed Energy Resources, and Related Matters* issued March 9, 2017 in the subject proceedings (the "Order"), Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid") hereby submits the following leaves:

The above leaves were first issued March 27, 2017 in compliance with the Order which directed utilities to make the revisions to their tariffs in conformance with the discussion in the body of the Order implementing the transition from net energy metering ("NEM") to Phase One NEM (as part of the Value of Distributed Energy Resources ("VDER") Phase One tariff) with an effective date of April 1, 2017. After discussions with New York State Department of Public Service Staff ("Staff"), it was determined that the effective date of the above leaves be postponed to April 27, 2017 in order to provide additional time for Staff review of each of the utilities' tariff filings. On March 31, 2017, National Grid filed a supplement to implement the postponement and requested that the supplement be allowed to be become effective on less than statutory notice. Following the completion of Staff's review of the tariff filings and upon Staff's request, National Grid made some additional edits to the leaves.
