## Re: Case 91-M-0927 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Administration of Utility Tariffs with Respect to Individually Negotiated Contracts Between Customers and Utilities – **Tariff Addendum**

Dear Secretary Burgess,

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation ("Distribution" or the "Company") hereby submits the following Addendum to its tariff, P.S.C. No. 9 – GAS:

Addendum No. 9

The Addendum bears an effective date of September 19, 2018 and supersedes Addendum No. 8 filed under subtype "GAS."

By way of background, this filing is being completed in compliance with Section 16, Leaf 8, Revision 1 (sub-part X), of the Company's currently effective tariff, as well as the New York State Public Service Commission's ("Commission") *Order Concerning Tariffs Authorizing Individually Negotiated Contracts* in Case 91-M-0927, issued and effective May 8, 1992.

In a companion filing submitted by the Company today in Case 91-M-0927, Distribution has filed a Transportation Agreement with the New York State Public Service Commission, 30 days prior to becoming effective.

This instant filing addresses the latter requirement of sub-part X, which requires the Company to append the new Transportation Agreement to its tariff rate schedule. As such, the Addendum has been updated to reflect negotiated rates from individual contracts between Distribution and its customers.

Concurrent with this filing, Distribution respectfully requests a waiver from the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1, pertaining to newspaper publication. The proposed tariff changes are being made for consistency and clarification purposes, the revisions are largely non-substantive in customer effect, and therefore the expense of publication would not serve the public interest.
