Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") amendments to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY (the "Tariff"). The revised tariff leaves and addendum, which are identified below, have an effective date of July 19, 2018.

Reason for Filing and Tariff Changes

The Commission in its Order Granting Clarification, issued and effective July 13, 2018, in Case 18-E-0018 (the "Order"), among other things, revised the existing Standardized Interconnection Requirements to include interconnection requirements for energy storage systems connected in parallel with utility distribution systems. The title of the Standardized Interconnection Requirements has been changed to "New York State Standardized Interconnection Requirements and Application Process for New Distributed Generators and Energy Storage Systems 5 MW or Less Connected in Parallel with Utility Distribution Systems" (the "SIR").

The Commission directed the major electric utilities to incorporate into their electric tariffs the revised SIR as shown in Exhibit A of the Order and to remove any inconsistent tariff provisions. Pursuant to the Order, the Company is filing changes to the Tariff to reflect the new name of the SIR. The Company is also filing the Commission's revised SIR as Tariff Addendum SIR-10.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 1 of the Order, the Tariff changes and Addendum SIR-10 are being filed on not less than one day's notice, to become effective on July 19, 2018. As specified in Ordering Clause 2 of the Order, the Commission waived the requirement for newspaper publication.
