Dear Secretary Burgess:

In compliance with the New York Public Service Commission's (the "Commission") <u>Order Approving Electric & Gas Rate Plans in Accord with Joint Proposal</u>, issued and effective June 15, 2016 (the "Order"), Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E" or the "Company") is hereby filing revised Rate Adjustment Mechanism ("RAM") Statements to be effective September 1, 2018.

RAM Statement No. 2 to PSC 18 Electricity RAM Statement No. 2 to PSC 19 Electricity

The Company is filing revised RAM Statements to extend the effective date of the RAM Statement from July 1 to September 1 to accommodate changes to its billing system for collecting the RAM Surcharge¹. The additional time period will allow the Company to complete the changes to its system to collect the RAM Surcharge through the Transition Charge on a volumetric basis for non-demand billed service classifications, and through the Transition Charge on a demand basis for demand-billed service classifications, and testing of those changes prior to implementation.

The RAM surcharge rates included in the revised Statements reflect the collection of the \$11.4 million over a ten-month period, to keep future collection periods intact.
